The City of Issaquah created a Behavioral Health Program and Homeless Outreach function to help residents access mental health and/or substance use services along with related support services including housing, health supports, transportation, vocational and educational services. The following services are available at no cost and on a voluntary basis:

- Connections to mental health, substance use, trauma treatment, crisis intervention.
- Assistance with housing, shelter resources, rental assistance, cash assistance.
- Health supports with insurance enrollment, finding primary care, telehealth access.
- Support with the service intake process and follow-along to ensure successful service integration and completion.
